

How to Collect Your Stool Sample Start Here...



Write your name and date of birth on the tube labels as shown here.


HOW TO CATCH THE SAMPLE
It is important that your stool
does not touch the toilet water. There
are different ways to collect your sample,
try:

- A. Several layers of folded toilet paper
- B. Hand inside a small plastic bag/glove
- C. A clean disposable container


Write your name and date of birth AND the date that the sample was taken on the label on the green bag.



You may find a way that is easier for you, but make sure you catch your stool before it touches the water.




COLLECTING THE SAMPLE
Unscrew the top of the sample
tube anti-clockwise and scrape the end
of the stick along the stool sample.



PACKAGING THE SAMPLE
Place your sample tube into the
green plastic bag and press along the seal.

RETURN YOUR SAMPLE
Seal the envelope and return it to your GP surgery without delay.



Ensure that the end of the stick is covered in sample but do not coat the rest of the stick. Replace the stick into the sample tube and twist clockwise to close securely. Only do this ONCE.



Place the green sample bag AND the GP request form inside the GP return envelope.



Please check you have completed all the steps and return your sample to your GP surgery immediately

Your test result will be returned directly to your GP within 10 days. If you have not heard from your GP within 2 weeks please contact them.
